## Day 1 – Saturday 27<sup>th</sup> October

### **CLASS 1 Intro B (2009) – Warm Up Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

### **\*CLASS 2 Intro A (2008) Restricted – Championship Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships. They must not have won a Prelim class affiliated or unaffiliated before the date of qualification.

### **CLASS 3 Prelim 12 (2005) – Warm-Up Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

### **\*CLASS 4 Prelim 14 (2006) Restricted – Championship Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

### **CLASS 5 Novice 27 (2007) – Warm-up Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

### **\* CLASS 6 Novice 28 (2008) Restricted – Championship Class**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships.

## **CLASS 7 Freestyle Dressage to Music**

This is open to all competitors who have qualified for the above championship classes. Open Music Freestyle: Intro 2012 20x40m arena / Preliminary 2012 20x40m or 20x60m / Novice 2012 20x40 or 20x60m arena

You must hand over your music CD on declaration. Horse/pony Rider combinations do not need to qualify for this class, it is an optional extra but it must be pre-entered and you must declare at what level you will be doing your test.

*\*Incorporating Junior section for Children 14 years and younger on 27/10/2012. Prizes will be awarded separately for juniors*

Please note A horse and rider combination that is eligible for the Intro Walk and Trot class can only compete in the Preliminary Restricted as a second class at the finals. A horse and rider combination that is eligible for the restricted sections of Prelim and Novice cannot compete in any other class but they can compete in both prelim and novice restricted if they qualify for both.

## **Day 2 – Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> October**

A horse and rider combination that is eligible for the restricted classes of the Walk/trot, prelim and novice cannot compete together in the classes scheduled for Sunday 28th October at Patchetts EC

### **CLASS 8 Prelim 14 (2006) – Warm-Up Class**

For horse and rider combinations who may have competed BD dressage but have no BD points.

### **\*CLASS 9 Prelim 18 (2002) – Championship Class**

For horse and rider combinations who may have competed BD dressage but have no BD points.

### **Class 10 Novice 27 (2007) – Warm-up Class**

For horse and rider combinations who may have gained BD points at novice level but not higher.

**\*Class 11 Novice 28 (2008) Championship Class**

For horse and rider combinations who may have gained points BD at novice level but not higher.

**Class 12 Elementary 42 (2008) Medium 63 (2002) Warm-Up Class - combined**

Open to all except horse and rider combinations that competed on Day 1

**Class 13 Elementary 44 (2002) Championship Class**

Open to all except horse and rider combinations that competed on Day 1

**Class 14 Medium 63 (2002) Championship Class**

Open to all except horse and rider combinations that competed on Day 1

**CLASS 15 Dressage to Music**

Open to all horse and riders who are competing in any of the Chiltern & Thames Rider Championships Classes on Sunday 28th October. You must hand over your music CD on declaration. Horse/pony Rider combinations do not need to qualify for this class, it is an optional Open Music Freestyle all 20x60m arena: Novice 2012/ Elementary 2012/ Medium 2012. **This class must be pre-entered and you must declare at what level you will be doing your test.**

*\*Incorporating Junior section for Children 14 years and younger on 28/10/2012.*

Rosettes to 10th place. Sash to Winners including best juniors. Mounted Prize Giving for top 6 placings in each class. Prizes generously sponsored by Amtrust.

**Rules:**

**Horses or ponies may be ridden by two riders at the championships but the following restrictions apply:**

They can only compete at two consecutive levels. Eg if rider 1 competes with the horse and pony at Prelim Level, rider 2 cannot compete at any other level other than Intro (one level below) or Novice (one level above).

They cannot compete in the same class.

Both rider/horse/pony combinations must qualify to be able to ride at the finals

This competition will be run under British Dressage rules

Please note: no dressage whips to be used in the arena, no boots or bandages and callers can only be used for juniors (14 years and under) or riders who have proof of special needs (discretion of the show organiser)

If competitors go up a grade from qualification to the date of the final, they must declare this and they will be moved up, into a suitable level of class for the final.

If a horse and rider combination qualifies at restricted level and then goes on to qualify at non-restricted level in another class, the restricted qualification must be upgraded to the non-restricted section of the class. Alternatively, the rider can surrender the non-restricted qualification, and compete at restricted level in both Prelim and Novice. You have to make a choice of level - either all classes restricted or non-restricted.

Please do not enter classes for which you are not eligible. If anyone enters illegally, they will be disqualified. Please note that spot checks will be made to authenticate entries.

**PLEASE COMPLETE AN ENTRY FORM FOR THE ABOVE CLASSES**

Championship Classes and Music Classes: ENTRY COST: £21.44 per test when you enter online or £24.49 if you enter over the phone or on paper.

Warm-Up Classes: ENTRY COST £18 when you enter online or £21 when you enter over the phone or on paper.
