- 1) Mini Show Jumping Ponies** *for ponies not exceeding 148cm*
- Pony and rider combination not to have won any notional money BS at the time of qualification (This is money registered on BS record)
  - Height – 70cm first round
  - Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition)
  - Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving so please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

**Follows on**

- 2) Novice Show Jumping Ponies** *for ponies not exceeding 148cm*
- Pony and rider combination not to have won more than £50 notional money BS at the time of qualification.
  - Height – 80cm first round
  - Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if entries very high)
  - Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving so please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

**Approx 12.30 - 1.30 CLEAR ROUND FOR PONIES AT 90cm.** Cost per round £5.

Riders to buy their tickets at the collecting ring.

- 3) Small Open Jumping Ponies** *for ponies not exceeding 148cm but open to all*
- Open to all qualified pony and rider combinations.
  - Height – 90cm first round
  - Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if entries are very high)
  - Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving so please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

- 4) Open Show Jumping Ponies** *(for ponies not exceeding 148cm but open to all)*
- Open to qualified pony and rider combinations only.
  - Height – 1m first round
  - Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if very high entries)
  - Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving so please ensure that you can attend or be represented.
- 5) The Equestrian.co.uk Jump Challenge** *Open to all ponies*
- This is a non qualifier open to all 'puissance' class
  - In each round competitors will be required to jump 2 fences (smaller than the 'puissance' fence) and then the 'puissance' fence.
  - The 'puissance' fence will be an upright (**it will not be a wall**)

- The first round will start at 80cm
- Competitors who successfully jump the 'puissance' go through to the next round.
- In each round the height will increase until a winner is determined
- Riders will be eliminated if they refuse, knock down or fall off at the 'puissance' fence
- Competitors are allowed one refusal and knock down at either of the 2 warm up fences in each round
- Rosettes to 10th place

### **6) Mini Show Jumping Horses** (*for horses exceeding 148cm*)

- Horse and rider combination not to have won any notional money BS at the time of qualification (This is money registered on BS record)
- Height – 70cm first round
- Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if entries very high)
- Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving so please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

### **7) Novice Show Jumping Horses** (*for horses exceeding 148cm*)

- Horse and rider combination not to have won more than £50 notional BS at the time of qualification (This is money registered on BS record)
- Height – 80cm first round
- Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition)
- Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving, please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

**Approx 12.30 - 1.30 CLEAR ROUND FOR PONIES AT 90cm.** Cost per round £5

Riders to buy their tickets at the collecting ring.

### **8) Small Open Jumping Horses** (*for horses exceeding 148cm but open to all*)

- Open to all qualified horse and rider combinations only.
- Height – 90cm first round
- Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if entries very high)
- Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving, please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

### **9) Open Show Jumping Horses** (*for horses exceeding 148cm but open to all*)

- Open to qualified horse and rider combinations only.
- Height – 1m first round
- Table A7 (may be run as a Two Phase competition if very high entries)
- Rosettes and prizes to 10th place and a sash to the champion. Mounted prize giving, please ensure that you can attend or be represented.

## **10) The Equestrian.co.uk Jump Challenge *Open to all horses***

- This is a non qualifier open to all 'puissance' class
- In each round competitors will be required to jump 2 fences (smaller than the 'puissance' fence) and then the 'puissance' fence.
- The 'puissance' fence will be an upright (**it will not be a wall**)
- The first round will start at 90cm
- Competitors who successfully jump the 'puissance' go through to the next round.
- In each round the height will increase until a winner is determined
- Riders will be eliminated if they refuse, knock down or fall off at the 'puissance' fence
- Competitors are allowed one refusal and knock down at either of the 2 warm up fences in each round
- Rosettes to 10th place

### Important Notes For Competitors

#### **Eligibility**

This championship show is open to competitors who have purchased a CT Rider Summer Show Jumping Membership Number for 2012 and have qualified at a recognised Chiltern and Thames Rider qualifying show, and have entered by the close of entries on Tuesday 4th September 2012 (*except for late shows*)

Horse/pony combinations cannot enter more than two classes and they must be consecutive. ie mini and novice, novice and small open, small open and open except for the equestrian.co.uk jump challenge which can be entered as a third class.

#### **Special Rules**

This show will be run under the guidance of BS rules with the following exceptions:

- Competitors will be permitted one extra refusal/disobedience, meaning that elimination will follow the third and not the second refusal/disobedience.

### **ALL CLASSES WILL BE DRAWN ORDER EXCEPT THE EQUESTRIAN.CO.UK JUMP CHALLENGE.**

#### **Numbers**

For online entries, competitors will automatically be issued with a number. Take a note of this number and pick up the card number, to wear in the ring, from the Secretary's tent on the day of the show. Riders must wear their correct number when competing.

## Chiltern Equine Clinic CT Rider Show Jumping Championships - General rules

- All riders must wear protective headgear which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened, when jumping in the arena, the practice area and the collecting ring. It is mandatory for all members to wear a protective helmet manufactured to EN1384, ASTM F 1163, PAS 015 or SNELL E2001 with Kite Mark or SEI or such other suitable protective headgear as offers a similar or higher level of protection and is at least that of EN1384, ASTM F 1163 or PAS 015.
- All ridden horses must be 4 years or over
- Only the next 10 horses/ponies to jump should be in the collecting ring at any time. Competitors asked by the steward to leave the collecting ring should do so immediately.
- Competitors must ensure that they warm-up in the correct collecting ring
- Qualifiers are not eligible to enter the final unless they are Chiltern & Thames Rider Summer Show Jumping Members for 2012. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without giving a reason
- The organisers and land owners will not be held responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, spectators or any person or property whatsoever, however caused. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident
- **The decision of the judge/organiser is final**
- The judge has the right to query any entrant's eligibility for entry into a class e.g. height of pony, BS winnings etc. If an entrant is found to be ineligible, they will be dismissed from the class and their fee will not be refunded
- All horses or ponies, when outside the arena, should be moved at the walk only, to ensure the safety of spectators and pedestrians
- Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times
- If any person lodges an objection, such an objection should be made in writing, and a £50 deposit paid, to the Secretary within half an hour of the event. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained
- The expense of any veterinary services rendered either on or after the show must be borne by the competitor or owner of stock
- Any point not covered may be referred to The Secretary whose decision is final
- Entry constitutes an agreement to be bound by and to abide by these rules & regulations health and safety. Reasonable precautions will be taken to ensure the health & safety of persons present. For these measures to be effective, competitors must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the judges and officials
- Children under the age of 16 years should be accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 18 years, who will be held responsible for their behaviour and welfare.
- If anyone falls off, they will have to leave the ring and they will be eliminated from the class
- Refunds will only be given on the production of a vet's certificate. £5 will be levied to cover administrative expenses
- In the event of the show being cancelled, if an alternative date can be scheduled in 2012, entries will be transferred to that day. No refunds will be given to entrants who cannot attend the re-scheduled day. If the show has to be abandoned for 2012, a percentage of the entry fees will be refunded but the organisers reserve the right to retain a fair percentage of the fees when Chiltern & Thames Rider has incurred considerable expenses in organising the show
- Cantering or galloping on the showground is not permitted except in the show rings or within the defined warm up areas
- Any competitor or supporter who by word or act is abusive or discourteous to a judge, organiser, landowner or official will be disqualified from the class and may be ordered off the show ground. If any competitor is so expelled, they will not be refunded with any entry fees

- No lungeing is permitted in the horsebox or car parking areas
- Horse boxes must not be mucked out onto the showground. Anyone seen doing this will be ordered to leave the showground
- Classes will not be held up to wait for competitors who are competing in another ring
- Competitors are responsible for entering classes and if two of their classes clash it is their responsibility and refunds will not be given
- The times for classes starting are approximate only
- Persons showing cruel or excessive use of force or deliberate neglect of any animal on the showground will be reported to the police
- Rider Substitutions for qualified rider will only be allowed if the rider can prove by way of a medical letter or certificate that they cannot compete at the championships on 16th Sept 2012. Also any substitutions accepted by the show must be deemed to be suitably qualified to compete in the place of the qualified rider. If there is any doubt to the rider suitability, the show organiser or judge has the right to refuse to allow the substituted rider to compete. They may be asked to leave the ring. If this case were to happen, no refunds would be granted.
