### **CLASS 1 Intro**

#### **\* Intro Test A (2008) Restricted Championship**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships

### **CLASS 2 Preliminary Restricted**

#### **\*Preliminary No. 13 (2006) Restricted Championship**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships

### **CLASS 3 Preliminary Open**

#### **\*Preliminary No. 14 (2006) Open Championship**

For horse and rider combinations who may have competed BD dressage but do not have any BD points. Please note horse and rider combinations are not allowed to enter both the prelim restricted and open sections.

### **CLASS 4 Novice Restricted**

#### **\*Novice No. 30 (2006) Restricted Championship**

Neither horse nor rider to have competed BD Affiliated Dressage by the date of the championships

## **CLASS 5 Novice Open**

### **\*Novice No. 34 (2009) Open Championship**

For horse and rider combinations who may have gained points at novice level but not higher.

Please note horse and rider combinations are not allowed to enter both the prelim restricted and open sections.

*\*Incorporating Junior section for Children 14 years and younger on 15/04/12 riding ponies and horses of any height*

A horse and rider combination that is eligible for the restricted classes cannot compete in any other class but they can compete in all three restricted classes if they qualify for them. Intro Restricted, Prelim Restricted and Novice Restricted

## **CLASS 6 Elementary**

### **Elementary No. 57 (2007) Championship**

Open to all except horse and riders who are competing in the restricted sections . 60 x 20 arena

## **CLASS 7 Medium**

### **Medium No. 69 (2005) Championship**

Open to all except horse and riders who are competing in the restricted sections . 60 x 20 arena

## **CLASS 8 Dressage to Music (Choose your own level)**

Open to all horse and riders who are competing in any of the Chiltern & Thames Rider Championships Classes. You can choose a 20 x 40 or 20 x 60m arena at the end of all the other classes. You must hand over your music CD on declaration. Please indicate on your entry (in the 'commentary' section on line) what level of freestyle you are performing and what size arena you need.

*Horses and ponies may be ridden by two riders on the day but both riders must be CTR members and only consecutive classes may be entered eg prelim and novice.*

No horse or rider substitutions are allowed. No horse may enter more than three classes at the championships.

Rosettes to 10<sup>th</sup> place. Sash to Winners including best juniors. Mounted Prize Giving for top 6 placings in each class.

**Chess Valley Equine will be sponsoring the rosettes and sashes. Amtrust are supplying the prizes.**

Prizes for children – a good selection of prizes will be awarded for the children's sections, dependent on entries.

**This competition will be run under British Dressage rules**

**Please note: no dressage whips, boots or bandages to be used in the arena and callers can only be used for juniors (14 years and under) or for riders with 'special needs'.**

**If competitors go up a level from qualification to the date of the final, they must declare this and they will be moved up, into a suitable level of class for the final.**

**Please do not enter classes for which you are not eligible. If anyone enters illegally, they will be disqualified. Please note that spot checks will be made to authenticate entries.**
